The Walnut Street Garage Capital Repairs update for 2020. Desman conducted additional surveys and uncovered additional emergency repair for a total of \$298,000.00. The work is progressing.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT

A lease agreement was entered in June 2020 between 810 Mill, LLC for 15 parking spaces in the Old York Rd. Lot. They have asked to lease an additional 3 parking spaces under the same term as the initial 15 spaces.

Mr. Jim Broughal asked for a motion to approve the Execution of The First Amendment to the Parking Space Lease Agreement to increase the number or parking spaces from 15 to 18. The Redevelopment Authority of the City of Bethlehem is going to contribute to the Bethlehem Parking Authority the sum of \$500,000 to reimburse the Bethlehem Parking Authority for the acquisition of the land at E. The \$500,000 has to be utilized in two ways; to pay down the debt on the loan to acquire the land or put the \$500,000 in a segregated account to be used for the future cost of construction of the Polk Street Garage.

Mr. Jim Broughal asked for a motion to approve the execution by the Chairman of the agreement between the Redevelopment Authority and the Bethlehem Parking Authority for the receipt of those funds. WSG Site Feasibility Study

In 2014, Desman Design Management evaluated the condition of the Walnut Street Garage and at that time based on the surveys performed, the WSG was in need of \$5,000,000.00 in repairs. Between the years of 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018, the Bethlehem Parking Authority invested \$600,000 in repairs. In 2019 and 2020 the ongoing repairs have been \$600,000. The survey performed in June of 2020 determined the WSG has continued to deteriorate. Based on the survey just completed, Desman is forecasting \$12,000,000 to \$14,000,000 in capital improvements in order to maintain the WSG for 15 years.

Mr. Steve Fernstrom stated no final decision has been made on design or construction of the Walnut Street Garage.

Ms. Lynn Cunningham asked how many spaces were in the WSG? Mr. Steve Fernstrom stated, 777 spaces and normally the garage is full especially during holiday weekends and Musikfest.

Mr. Eric Evans, Business Administrator for the City of Bethlehem asked Mr. Tim Tracy, if voted on by the Board, what's the timeline of the steps mentioned in the study? Mr. Tim Tracy said roughly 6 months from initiation to having it publicly presented.

Ms. Paige VanWirt asked if a representative from Desman be available for a presentation before City Council to inform them of what's going on? Mr. Tim Tracy agreed to the request.

Mr. Jim Broughal asked what was the cost? Mr. Steve Fernstrom replied, not to exceed \$42,500.

Ms. Lynn Cunningham made motion to approve the Site Feasibility Study. Mr. Eugene Gonzalez second the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
